Atlantic Coast Pipeline, LLC (Atlantic) filed its Geohazards Analysis Program Phase 2 Report on August 2, 2016 (FERC Accession Number 20160802-5107). An addendum to this report based on the current alignment and including additional survey data (LiDAR and field) and clarification based on comments from agencies is provided as Appendix A.

2.0 ENVIRONMENTAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES**2.1 Biological Survey Reports**

Atlantic and Dominion Transmission, Inc. (DTI) are conducting surveys for various rare, threatened, and endangered species and/or habitat for these species as recommended by the U.S. Forest Service (USFS), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), and State/Commonwealth wildlife management agencies. With this filing, Atlantic is providing the following biological survey reports for the Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP):

- Northern Long-Eared Bat Hibernacula Report for West Virginia;
- Northern Long-Eared Bat Hibernacula Report for Virginia; and
- Chowanoke and North Carolina Spiny Crayfish Survey Report for North Carolina.

Copies of these reports are provided in Appendix B. Because the reports contain location information for sensitive species, they have been filed under separate cover. The reports are marked “Contains Privileged Information – Do Not Release”.

The Northern Long-Eared Bat Hibernacula Report for West Virginia was submitted to the USFWS, USFS, and West Virginia Department of Natural Resources on May 12, 2017 for review and comment. A copy of Atlantic’s transmittal letter to the agencies is provided with the report in Appendix B.

The Northern Long-Eared Bat Hibernacula Report for Virginia was submitted to the USFWS, USFS, Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, and Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation on May 12, 2017 for review and comment. 3.0 RESPONSE TO RECOMMENDATIONS AND COMMENTS FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA ON THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) is responsible for coordinating state agency review of Federal environmental documents prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act and responding to Federal officials on behalf of the Commonwealth of Virginia. On April 6, 2017, VDEQ filed with FERC the recommendations and comments of the Commonwealth on the draft Environmental Impact Statement for the ACP and SHP (FERC Accession Number 20170406-5489). Atlantic provided responses to the recommendations and comments in a letter to VDEQ dated May 11, 2017. A copy of Atlantic's letter is provided in Appendix E, with the exception of an attachment to this letter containing location information for sensitive species. This attachment has been filed under separate cover as Appendix F; the attachment is marked "Contains Privileged Information – Do Not Release".
