


Figure 1. 007-0447, sketch map.




Figure 5. 007-0463, sketch map.




Figure 8. 007-0463, Barn 2, facing northeast.




Figure 10. 007-0467, sketch map.




Figure 14. 007-0476, sketch map.




Figure 22. 007-0476, outhouse, facing southwest.




Figure 23. 007-0487, sketch map.




Figure 28. 007-0490, sketch map.




Figure 32. 007-0863, sketch map.




Figure 36. 007-5703, sketch map.




Figure 40. 007-5704, sketch map.




Figure 43. 007-5705, sketch map.




Figure 48. 007-5706, sketch map.




Figure 53. 007-5709, sketch map.




Figure 63. 007-5710, sketch map.




Figure 67. 007-5711, sketch map.




Figure 70. 007-5712, sketch map.




Figure 75. 007-5713, sketch map.




Figure 79. 007-5714, sketch map.




Figure 80. 007-5714, barn, facing east.




Figure 83. 007-5715, sketch map.




Figure 87. 007-5716, sketch map.




Figure 91. 007-5716, shed, facing southeast.




Figure 93. 007-5717, sketch map.




Figure 102. 007-5717, sketch map.




Figure 106. 007-5718, sketch map.




Figure 111. 007-5719, sketch map.




Figure 114. 007-5720 sketch map.




Figure 119. 007-5721, sketch map.




Figure 122. 007-5722, sketch map.




Figure 125. 007-5723, sketch map.




Figure 129. 007-5724, sketch map.




Figure 133. 007-5725, sketch map.




Figure 137. 007-5726, sketch map.




Figure 140. 007-5727, sketch map.




Figure 143. 007-5728, sketch map.




Figure 148. 007-5729, sketch map.




Figure 155. 007-5730, sketch map.




Figure 157. 007-5730, facing northeast.




Figure 159. 007-5730, Shed 1 and Shed 2, facing northeast.




Figure 164. 007-5731, sketch map.




Figure 165. 007-5731, facing south.




Figure 167. 007-5731, shed, facing south.




Figure 168. 007-5732, sketch map.




Figure 171. 007-5733, sketch map.




Figure 174. 007-5733, house, facing northwest.




Figure 177. 007-5734, sketch map.




Figure 181. 007-5735, sketch map.




Figure 183. 007-5736, sketch map.




Figure 188. 007-5737, sketch map.




Figure 191. 007-5738 sketch map.




Figure 193. 007-5738, facing northwest.




Figure 197. 007-5739, sketch map.




Figure 199. 007-5740, sketch map.




Figure 201. 008-0011, sketch map.




Figure 209. 008-0011, facing south.




Figure 210. 008-0126, sketch map.




Figure 215. 008-5008, sketch map.




Figure 218. 008-5064, sketch map.




Figure 221. 008-5065, sketch map.




Figure 224. 008-5066, sketch map.




Figure 229. 008-5067, sketch map.




Figure 231. 014-5085, sketch map.




Figure 240. 014-5086, sketch map.




Figure 243. 026-5256, sketch map.




Figure 246. 026-5257, sketch map.




Figure 250. 045-5088, sketch map.




Figure 254. 062-5223, sketch map.




Figure 256. 062-5223, outbuilding, facing southeast.




Figure 258. 087-5669, sketch map.




Figure 263. 133-0101, sketch map.




Figure 265. 133-0101, primary entrance, facing southeast.




Figure 272. 133-5443, sketch map.




Figure 277. 133-5580, sketch map.




Figure 280. 133-5581, sketch map.
