Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI) is submitting supplemental information to support the Proposed State Water Quality Certification Required by Section 401 of the Clean Water Act for the Supply Header Project (SHP).

DETI has included a digital copy of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC's) Final Environmental Impact Statement for the SHP and Atlantic Coast Pipeline published on July 21, 2017 and a copy of the alternatives analysis submitted to the FERC on September 18, 2015 in support of DETI's Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate the proposed SHP facilities..

DETI is in the process of developing a detailed wetland compensatory mitigation plan for 0.23 acre of forested wetland that will be converted to emergent wetland due to operation of the SHP. It is anticipated that a detailed conceptual mitigation plan will be provided to the PADEP for review by early November 2017. DETI will continue to update the PADEP staff as the plan is completed.

Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI) is submitting additional information supporting the addendum to the Erosion and Sediment Control General Permit (ESCGP-2) application. DETI is also submitting an addendum to the Federal Pennsylvania State Programmatic General Permit 5 (PASPGP-5) Chapter 105 General Permit Registration (Chapter 105 Permit Application) for the Supply Header Project (Project).

DETI met with the Westmoreland Conservation District staff on September 21, 2017 to review the draft addendum ESCGP-2 application. Westmoreland Conservation District staff suggested comments and additions to the draft application and those revised documents are included in this package to complete the ESCGP-2 application addendum submittal.

DETI submits an addendum to the Chapter 105 Permit Application to revise the General Permit (GP) for crossing wetland wwmh005e from a GP-7 for Minor Road Crossing to a GP-8 for Temporary Road Crossing. This update reflects informal comments received by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection during review of the 401 Water Quality Certification application for the Project.

DETI has coordinated the fee for the ESCGP-2 and Chapter 105 Permit Application addendums, presented collectively within this submittal.
