Atlantic Coast Pipeline, LLC (Atlantic) and Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (Dominion Energy) are conducting field investigations for archaeological sites, historic architectural sites, and other cultural resources. With this filing, Atlantic and Dominion Energy are providing the following cultural resources reports for the Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP) and Supply Header Project (SHP):

- *Phase I Historic Architectural Survey of the Atlantic Coast Pipeline Project, Virginia Assessment of Effects Report, Revision 1* – a revised report for the ACP addressing comments from the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR); and
- *Supply Header Project, Wetzel, Tyler, Doddridge, Harrison, and Ritchie Counties, West Virginia, Phase I Cultural Resources Survey Report, Addendum 3* – a new report for the SHP describing the results of recently completed cultural resources surveys.

Atlantic sent the Virginia report to the VDHR on October 19, 2017. Copies of this report and the transmittal letter to the VDHR are provided in Appendix A. Atlantic will file comments on the report from the VDHR, when available.

Dominion Energy sent the West Virginia report to the West Virginia Department of Culture and History (WVDCH) on October 19, 2017. Copies of this report and the transmittal letter to the WVDCH are provided in Appendix B, which has been filed under separate cover. Because the report contains location information for archaeological sites, Appendix B is marked “Contains Controlled Unclassified Information and Contains Privileged Information - Do Not Release”. Dominion Energy will file comments on the report from the WVDCH, when available.

1.2 COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF CULTURAL RESOURCES REPORTS

Atlantic and Dominion Energy filed comprehensive tables listing cultural resource reports submitted to date, and pending reports with estimated dates of submittal, by state and Project, as Q5 Attachment 1 of their response to FERC’s Environmental Information Request dated September 20, 2017 (response filed on September 27, 2017; FERC Accession Number 20170927-5104). Revisions to these tables were provided with Atlantic’s and Dominion Energy’s supplemental filing on October 13, 2017 (FERC Accession Number 20171013-5176). Updates to the tables incorporating the cultural resources reports included with this filing are provided in Appendix C.

2.0 AGENCY CORRESPONDENCE
