In accordance with Dominion Transmission Inc.'s (DTI's) J.B. Tonkin Compressor Station Title V Operating Permit (65-00634) and PA RACT II Regulations, DTI has completed emissions testing of Engine 1 at J.B. Tonkin Compressor Station, located in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. The tests were conducted on October 18, 2016 for nitrogen oxides (NOx), carbon monoxide (CO), and volatile organic compounds (VOCs).

Submittal of the final test report is required within sixty (60) days of completing testing at the facility. To address this requirement, two (2) copies of the test report for these emissions tests are enclosed. In addition, one copy of this test report is being submitted to the US EPA.

As indicated in the enclosed reports, tested emissions from the unit were below emission limits.
